Let There Be Light!

For reptiles to thrive, they need lighting that mimics natural sunlight. Without it, they can suffer from vitamin D3 deficiencies and miss out on important visual stimulation. Make sure to use a specialised reptile light that's appropriate for your specific species. A timer is a great addition too, as it can help you replicate the natural day-night cycle. And don't forget about distance—ensure the light source is at the right height from your pet's basking spot. A quick tip: fluorescent lights should be replaced every six months to keep your pet basking in the best light possible!
